The gun show profits directly support the Rapid City Rifle Club Junior Division (RCRC) which is a state nonprofit corporation as well as a registered 501-C.3 federal tax-exempt corporation. Our primary goal is youth and adult education support of the Second Amendment and to promote the safe use of firearms in a positive manner with ethical hunting in mind.

RCRC is affiliated with the Civilian Marksmanship Program, National Rifle Association, SD Shooting Sport Association, and US Shooting-Junior Olympic programs. We have operating education and competitive shooting sports in the western South Dakota community for over 35 years. Club members participated in adult pistol leagues, outdoor rifle competitions, and have supported the Lady's Pistol Shooting events.

In the last 30 years the club's focus has been towards youth marksmanship. We realize the future of firearms depends on the youngest generation being trained in the safe use and familiarity with all firearms. We feel it is extremely important preserve these values; and our contribution towards preserving this is to get the youth involved. Gun Show Guidelines and Policies

- Table rent is \$60 per wall table and \$55 per standard table with advance payment reserving tables and giving table selection priority. Reservations of tables includes 2 chairs and 2 vendor badges Additional badges may be purchased for \$5 each.
- Tables paid in full 30 days in advance are discounted to \$55 for wall tables and \$50 for standard tables.
- Electricity connection available for wall tables only with an additional \$40 fee.
- Wi-fi is available free of charge.
- Refunds given on a case of emergency/weather basis and guarantees with a 15-day advanced notice.
- All checks are to be made payable to Rapid City Rifle Club (RCRC)

Safety Requirements Policy

- No loaded firearms, no exceptions.
- All firearms must be made safe. All Firearms must be secured with nylon tie, and tied and locked open or closed so NO ammunition can be introduced.
- No open ammunition on the same table as with firearms present.
- If table is covered it must meet fire code requirements
- Egress and escape routes must be maintained for open access at all times.
- NO black powder.
